



Danger: Fireworks

During this time of year, fireworks play a vital role in our celebrations. However, it is important to remember that the display of, and launching of fireworks is not legal within the city limits of Munford.

Fireworks may be displayed only on July 4, December 31, and January 1 of each year. Times outside of these dates are illegal. It is also illegal for anyone under the age of 16 to display fireworks without the accompaniment of an adult over the age of 21. Violations of any of these laws may result in the confiscation of the fireworks and/or a citation to Court with a penalty resulting in as much as \$500.

Please take these few rules into consideration when displaying fireworks:

1. Age and adult supervision has been taken into account
2. Proper date and times
3. Direction the fireworks are being displayed are not hazardous to anyone else's property
4. Direction the fireworks are being displayed is not hazardous to any people or animals
5. The weather conditions are favorable to display fireworks, like high winds and dry or drought conditions
6. A first aid kit and a telephone are close at hand in case of an emergency
7. Some means of fire suppression is close at hand in case the fireworks set something on fire

If these simple rules are closely watched and taken into account, you and your family should have a great celebration!
