MINUTES – NOVEMBER 28TH, 2011

City of Munford Beer Board – Special Called Meeting and Public Hearing – *Monday, November 28th, 2011*, 7:00 p.m., Municipal Building, 69 College Street, Munford, Tennessee.

Present: Mayor Dwayne Cole; Aldermen Bob Forbess, Jack Foraker, Johnny Crigger and Terry Colin.

Absent: Aldermen Sue Arthur and Mike Durham.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Cole called the Beer Board meeting to order. He stated that the meeting had been properly advertised. The purpose of the meeting was to review the “On Premises” Beer Permit held by Dorothy Faye Justice for DOC HOLIDAYS STEAK & SPIRITS located at 120 Quinton Drive, Munford, Tennessee.

II. REVIEW OF VIOLATION and DISCUSSION – Selling Beer Off Premises

Mayor Cole stated that prior to the special called meeting, Dottie and Loye Justice met with him concerning the beer permit for Doc Holiday’s Steak & Spirits. After much discussion, Mrs. Justice relinquished the “On Premises” Beer Permit to the Mayor.

Mayor Cole requested the Board review MTAS’ letter referencing T.C.A. §57-5-103(a)(3), which contained the limitations on serving beer outside the premises of a permit holder (see attached letter from MTAS dated March 29, 2011). Mayor Cole restated the definition of “contiguous” as referenced in the letter.

Mayor Cole recognized an email from Mrs. Lauri Hutchison, who was present at the meeting. Her concerns expressed in the email pertained to activities of Doc Holiday’s serving alcoholic beverages to under-age patrons. (See email from Lauri Hutchison dated Monday, November 28th, 2011.)

After further discussion by the Board on the required action needed, a motion was presented by Alderman Foraker and seconded by Alderman Colin to suspend the “On Premises” Beer Permit for DOC HOLIDAYS STEAK & SPIRITS indefinitely. Motioned carried.

There was no other business on the agenda. The meeting was adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
