## Choosing Her Own Adventure

While the majority of Girl Scouts meet in a traditional troop setting, we know how busy today's girl is and that's why we developed Girl Scout Pathways.

Pathways are a fun, flexible and accessible way for any girl to participate and benefit from Girl Scouting. Each of the six Pathways gives girls the opportunity to explore their skills and interests and be inspired to reach their personal best through a variety of fun and enriching leadership experiences.

## Grade Levels

- Daisy:** Kindergarten - 1st grade
- Brownie:** 2nd - 3rd grade
- Junior:** 4th - 5th grade
- Cadette:** 6th - 8th grades
- Senior:** 9th - 10th grades
- Ambassador:** 11th - 12th grade

## Pathways Defined

- Camp** - Girls participate in day or resident camps with a focus on the out-of-doors and/or environmental education
- Events** - Girls participate in council-sponsored events geared toward specific interests
- Series** - Girls participate in a series of programs with the same group of girls relating to a specific theme or purpose (e.g., high-adventure teen group, Girl Scout Chorus)
- Travel** - Girls plan, earn money, prepare and participate in regional, national and international trips
- Troops** - Girls participate in a series of programs with the same group of girls over the course of an academic year
- Virtual** - Girls participate in interactive, high-quality program activities in a safe, secure, online environment supplemented by live events.

With Girl Scout Pathways girls can experience Girl Scouts in the way that best suits them. And having the ability to pick and chose any one, all or some of these Pathways – camp, events, series, travel, troops, and virtual, all within a single year making Girl Scouts the ideal extra-curricular activity for your girl.
